Public Progress Report

A public record of visible capability, meaningful validation, creator-control boundaries, and the next evidence required before controlled testing expands.

Public scope

This report describes product capability, author control, validation progress, limitations, and next milestones. It intentionally excludes private budgets, sales projections, competitor scoring, internal architecture, and confidential operations.

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1. Progress at a Glance

The manuscript-centered knowledge loop has completed a substantial internal literary qualification.

DraftAtlas keeps the manuscript central while approved project knowledge, evidence, maps, editorial review, consultation, recovery, and professional handoff remain connected around it.

Current status

Version 0.7.4 remains in evidence-led hardening. DraftAtlas is publicly visible, but it is not publicly downloadable, purchasable, or tied to a promised release date.

Latest progress

- A ten-work, 1.31-million-word internal literary cohort completed all configured manuscript search, Project Bible, classification, evidence, relationship, recommendation, and structure acceptance lanes.
- A blinded review of 120 entity recommendations measured 97.5% precision in the qualified development cohort.
- All ten isolated projects opened in the packaged Windows application with the Manuscript, Story Details, and Project Bible surfaces available and no horizontal overflow detected.
- The real project library remained unchanged during packaged qualification.
- Support and product-improvement consent are now separate. Improvement material remains optional, local, reviewable, and unsent by default.

2. The Working Product Loop

DraftAtlas connects writing and project knowledge without silently taking authority.

Write

- Draft and organize long-form work on a professional manuscript page with formatting, autosave, revisions, focus mode, document structure, and recovery foundations.

Review

- Inspect Story Details found in ordinary prose. Evidence remains visible, and the creator decides what should become approved project knowledge.

Understand

- Use the medium-appropriate Project Bible, backlinks, timelines, search, relationships, maps, Editorial Intelligence, and optional Consultation around approved project context.

Protect and hand off

- Create backups, restore points, recovery evidence, privacy-reviewed support reports, portable project files, and review-ready exports.

Creator authority

The system may discover. The creator decides. Proposals, AI output, and editorial findings do not silently rewrite prose or approved project knowledge.



3. Literary Validation

Large, varied manuscripts were used to test the complete semantic path.

What this supports

The result supports the claim that DraftAtlas can carry complete, structurally varied works through manuscript search, reviewable discovery, evidence linking, approved project knowledge, and the packaged desktop interface at strong development-cohort accuracy.

What it does not support

It does not claim perfect interpretation, universal literary recall, every language, every hardware class, or production readiness for an untouched release cohort. Fresh holdout and real-user evidence remain required.

4. Privacy and Optional Improvement

Support is not consent to use a creator's work for product improvement.

- Every support workflow defaults to Support only.
- An author may optionally prepare a redacted quality signal or write a reviewed example as a separate local packet.
- The exact packet remains visible before it is saved.
- The packet is not attached to Send Report and is not uploaded automatically.
- Project files, manuscript and Project Bible bodies, notes, relationships, assets, screenshots, local files, AI prompts and output, credentials, full diagnostics, logs, paths, crash dumps, and tester identity are excluded.
- DraftAtlas has not enabled model training, third-party sharing, telemetry, or a remote contribution endpoint.

Local-first boundary

The current feature establishes a reviewable local foundation. Any future submission program would require separate policy, consent, transport, retention, deletion, and release approval.



5. Current Product Areas

The same project can be written, understood, protected, and handed off without making AI mandatory.

Area	Current public description
Living Manuscript	Professional writing, semantic documents, revisions, focus mode, Story Details, and medium-aware structure.
Project Bible	Approved characters, places, recipes, lore, relationships, evidence, and project knowledge under creator control.
Editorial Intelligence	Purpose-aware deterministic findings and optional AI interpretation with evidence and review decisions.
Consultation	Optional project-grounded discussion with provider choice and a proposal return path rather than silent canon edits.
Maps and relationships	Zoomable spatial and relationship views with evidence, routes, weights, and project context.
Search, recovery, and support	Project isolation, local indexing, backups, restore points, diagnostics, privacy review, and receipt-based support.
Publish and export	DOCX, PDF, Markdown, HTML, project archives, and review or production handoff materials.

6. Known Boundaries

The product is capable, but the remaining evidence is not ceremonial.

- The qualified ten-work cohort is development evidence. A newly frozen, never-before-run release holdout still requires approval and execution.
- The final strict relationship recommendation sample was small, so broader fresh precision evidence remains necessary.
- Publisher signing and final clean-machine qualification are not complete.
- macOS remains a separate physical-hardware, signing, notarization, recovery, and support lane.
- Only languages that complete full UI, manuscript, discovery, Project Bible, search, editorial, consultation, import/export, and accessibility validation will be advertised.
- Local AI depth and speed vary materially by hardware and selected model.
- Publishing outputs are professional review and handoff artifacts, not printer-certified final production files.
- Accessibility, unusual scaling, long-session behavior, and edge-case recovery remain active qualification areas.
- Imported-source analysis must remain limited to material the user is authorized to analyze and should support, not replace, reading, scholarship, and professional judgment.

7. What Comes Next

Independent evidence now matters more than expanding the feature list.

- Run the fresh rights-approved release holdout without tuning against it.
- Freeze and verify an exact Windows candidate with checksums, privacy review, recovery instructions, and known limitations.
- Complete signed-installer, representative-hardware, display-scaling, output, accessibility, legal, security, and support checks.
- Run a 3-5 person trusted pilot, resolve shared blockers, then expand through focused cohorts only when the evidence supports it.
- Begin macOS and offered-language qualification only when each lane can be held to the same evidence and creator-control standard.

8. Public Principles

Capability is becoming visible without weakening release gates.

- The manuscript remains central.
- Project knowledge evolves with the work.
- Evidence and provenance remain inspectable.
- Deterministic findings and AI interpretations remain distinct.
- AI is optional.
- Support consent and improvement consent remain separate.
- No prose or approved knowledge is silently rewritten.
- The creator remains the authority over project truth.
- Local-first operation remains a core trust principle.

Operating rule

Do not accelerate unsafe distribution. Accelerate credible visibility, qualified audience formation, and evidence-backed readiness.

Chart your whole project.
