PUBLIC DEVELOPMENT UPDATE

DraftAtlas 0.7.8 Has Entered Its Next Independent QA Round

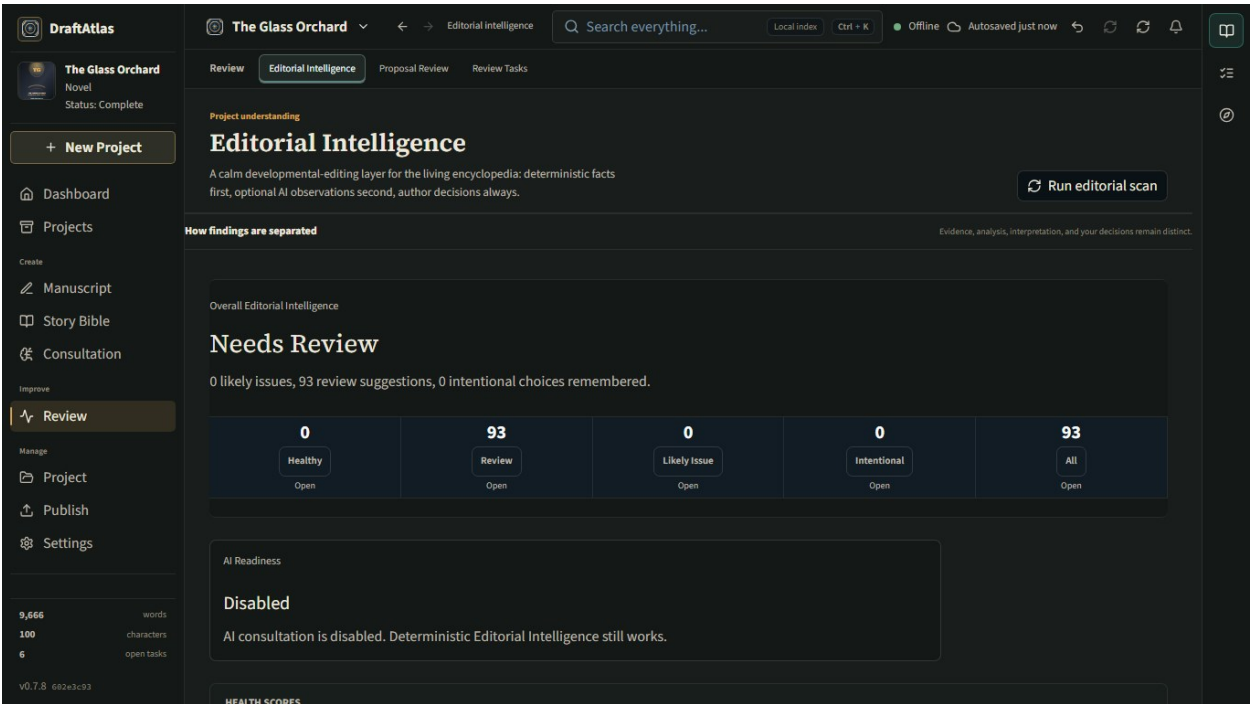
DraftAtlas has completed a broad internal quality sweep across the writing surface, Project Bible, discovery, seven creative media, output, recovery, visual systems, accessibility checks, optional intelligence, and Windows packaging.

The current build is now frozen for independent review. It remains in development, is not available for public download or purchase, and has no announced release date.

A FOCUSED QUALITY PASS, NOT A NEW FEATURE CAMPAIGN

What Improved

- Proposal Review now preserves its summary information at compact desktop widths.
- Shared controls across Project Bible, maps, portraits, tasks, image search, proposal review, and asset import have stronger accessible names.
- The visual quality gate now checks 62 routed surfaces at three desktop sizes for layout and accessibility regressions.
- Evidence-generation and candidate-freeze tools now verify copied artifacts before sealing them for review.
- Historical benchmark evidence is more clearly separated from current qualification results.



Editorial review remains connected to the project instead of becoming a separate utility.

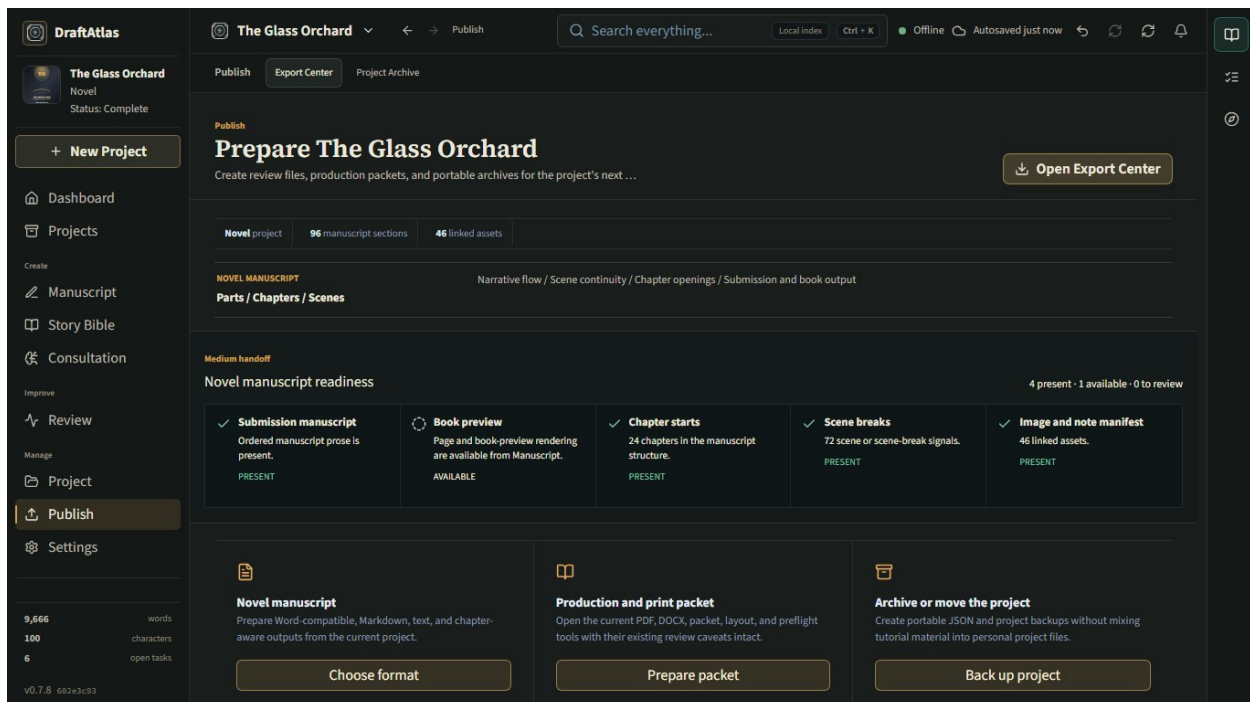
What Was Rechecked

Area	Public status
Writing and pagination	Sustained writing, autosave, page geometry, preview, and print handoff passed internal qualification
Project Bible and discovery	Evidence, author decisions, project isolation, and recovery passed internal qualification
Seven creative paths	Novel, Short Story, Screenplay, Picture Book, Comic / Graphic Novel, Cookbook, and Lore Bible / RPG workflows passed their current internal gates
Professional handoff	PDF, DOCX, screenplay, project archive, and visual artifact paths passed current internal checks
Recovery	Project restore, backups, destructive recovery, installer lifecycle, and project-library isolation passed
Visual library	The local governed catalog and expansion-pack architecture passed scale, provenance, and accessibility checks
Optional intelligence	Core workflows remain usable without AI; provider behavior remains separately governed

INDEPENDENT EVIDENCE BEFORE BROADER TESTING

What Happens Next

- An independent reviewer will test the frozen Windows candidate from a disposable workspace and return reproducible findings.
- Any material defect will be repaired and retested before the candidate advances.
- Later gates include unfamiliar human testing, professional review, accessibility, security/privacy, legal review, physical hardware qualification, signing, and support operations.
- Public visibility does not authorize public distribution or sale. Release timing remains evidence-led.



The output workspace prepares work to leave the studio while preserving the project behind it.

THE WORK REMAINS CENTRAL

The Governing Principle

The manuscript remains central. Project knowledge evolves with the work. Evidence remains visible. AI is optional. The creator decides what becomes approved project knowledge.

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
